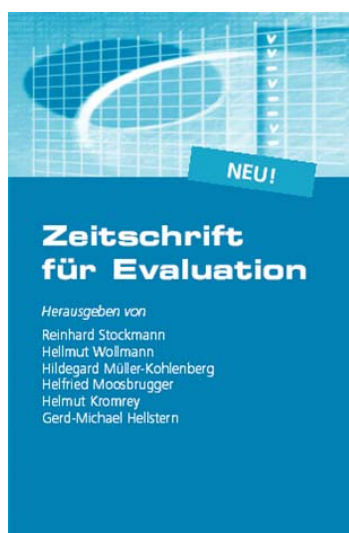
Wichtig und richtig! Aber: Ist nicht weniger mehr?

Abstract

The article commentates the standards of self evaluation (Beywl & Müller-Kohlenberg) from the perspective of an adviser of quality-management and evaluation processes in organisations of the social and education range, thus both before the background of a theoretically justified method and also regarding the questions of the practical application. First of all the standards have to be appreciated, because they support the self obligation character of self evaluation in empirical and professional regard and they also are able to express the practical use of the method. In this way many reproaches ("self-interest", "subjectivity") can be rejected. Nevertheless some critical and at the same time constructive notes are made, to prevent a turning away from secured empirical procedures because of a methodical and resource-referred excessive demand on the practitioners.
