

Instruction of Experts in Evaluation in Provence – An Interview with Michel Vial, Université de Provence

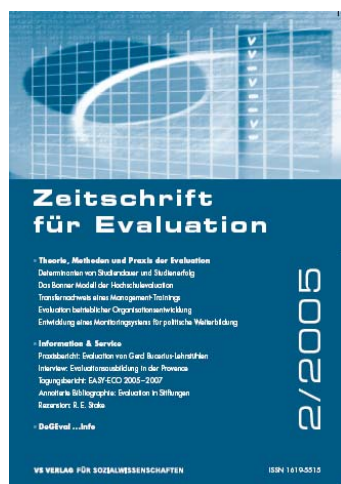

Abstract

Professional training in evaluation has not been existing for a long time. In Aix-Marseille University of Provence has been delivering master diplomas in evaluation since 1985. About twenty adult students prepare themselves to become consultants, experts or managers, specialize as coaches or quality counsellors. On the one hand university tries to offer them a large range of knowledge drawn from social sciences, philosophy and social psychology. On the other hand they are supposed and encouraged to become *reflexive practitioners* by working on their obligatory field experiences. The capacity of working in teams and co-managing conflicts are considered as core competencies.
